How thrilling it is for Becky and me to see God moving here at Grace Woodlands in such a powerful way. It is what we envisioned when Grace Woodlands began and what we have prayed for throughout the years. The many hundreds of new people have caused us to make adjustments to make room for everyone and to provide ministry for spiritual growth and development. We have reached the end of being able to stretch our current auditorium as we are at the maximum capacity of seats and expanded space. And God continues to bring many people our way. We are building new parking as fast as we can, and it seems to fill up as fast as we build it. What started as God adding people to Grace is now beginning to look like multiplication. What an exciting time. This is truly a "God" season... a kairos time.

CORNERSTONE 2023 is our next step. With this large step of faith we will build the cornerstone building on our church campus. This new worship center will accommodate 3,200 people... more than four times the amount of our present seating. This next step of preparing for what God will do is to get ready for multiplication. That is what I heard the Lord speak into my spirit at the end of last summer. Imagine what it will be like when thousands of voices fill this new worship center with praise to our God. Imagine the sound of thousands of people praying together where the cry of our intercession reaches the heavens. Imagine the impact of a multiplied congregation sharing their personal stories of God's transforming power in their everyday world.

This is a "kairos" time for Grace. It is a Divine interruption of what we have known as God moves powerfully by His Spirit. How we respond in preparing for the next chapter of the story He is writing over Grace is very important.

Becky and I ask you to join us in seeking the Lord for what your part will be in providing the resources for this place of worship and Divine encounter. We only ask that you approach this with a lot of prayer and a willing heart. This worship center will be built by those who are willing to bring a sacrifice to the Lord. Sacrifice is when we give up something we want or desire for something we desire more. It is about priorities and values. AN AMAZING STORY OF REDEMPTION

The story of Grace in the greater Houston area began with twelve people in the Clear Lake Intermediate School theater in 1983. Becky and I moved from the San Francisco Bay Area to begin the church. From that humble beginning, Grace grew by the power of the Spirit, from twelve to many thousands resulting in building one of the largest worship centers in the nation seating ten thousand people.

As we began to consider expanding the ministry of Grace beyond the Clear Lake/Space Community area of Houston, The Woodlands became our focus. Along with Grace International, God helped us purchase this tract of wasteland. It was 87 acres of abandoned sandpits that had been used up and overgrown. Over time it became a dumping ground for whatever people wanted to discard. It even had a marijuana farm growing on the back side. Neglected and abandoned, its value used up, it became a storage place for what had become broken and unwanted.



We began holding services in a local Christian school, and Grace Woodlands became a reality. As we began to clean up the site, built the first building, and continued the development to transform more and more of the site, I heard the Lord speak into my spirit one day that the story of the land was the story of Grace. What once had value and was productive, now used up and abandoned, had become virtually worthless. As a result, in its worthless condition, it had become only a place to dump broken things, further eroding its value. The story of the land was the story of broken human lives. The great news is that the story doesn't end there. You can see what has happened in the redeeming of this land and the restoring of its value every time you come here. The church campus that is now a spiritual home to thousands of people, the global headquarters for almost a half a million people around the world through Grace International, and the other businesses and housing that have located here all speak of redemption, restoration, and renewed value. The Lord spoke to me... just as the land is being redeemed and restored, I am doing the very same thing in people's lives.

THE STORY OF THIS LAND IS THE STORY OF GRACE.

When I first walked across this land in its broken condition, I not only saw the brokenness, I saw its potential. The land had obviously been in this ongoing deteriorating condition for many years. Where others saw something worth nothing, I saw potential and value. When the Lord spoke to me about the parallel between the natural and the spiritual, it was deeply impactful to me personally. As I participate in the ongoing development on this site, I marvel at what has happened and never fail to hear again those words the Lord spoke to me years ago... The story of this property is the story of Grace. And it is. The ministry of our church is about taking in broken people and looking at their lives; not by what they have done, but by what they can become. **This is the story of what God wants to do through a people called Grace.**

12 NIGHTS OF PENTECOST

EVERYTHING STARTED HERE

"Call the church together to pray for a fresh outpouring 12 nights before Pentecost."

That is what I heard the Lord say as we were navigating the beginning of the Covid season. God moved in a powerful way as 100-150 people came together every night, even though most churches weren't even open and meetings like ours were being labeled "super spreaders." As we moved past Pentecost Sunday, we continued to experience a fresh move of the Spirit. God began to add to the church... at first a few, which became a few hundred, and then many hundreds of people. The intensity of the presence of God became stronger and stronger. I will always remember the Wednesday night when the glory of God entered the auditorium in a tangible way. When Prayer Meeting was dismissed - no one left. So we started back up for two more hours.

Two and a half years later, "Here comes the Glory..." is more than a song for us. It is what we have experienced ongoingly during this season of God's outpouring... and continue to see on a regular basis. You can tangibly feel the presence of God come into the room. We have seen amazing stories of God at work in people's lives.

Our midweek Prayer Meetings have grown to hundreds of people crying out to God for revival and the healing of our land. All the weekend services have greatly grown in number and in the move of the Spirit. The place of our gathering has become too small for everything God is doing. We are now seeing the beginnings of multiplication all around us. None of us who experienced the 12 nights will ever forget Pentecost 2020 and what has happened since. It is a story God continues to write. Cornerstone will make room for God to continue to write this amazing story of a people called Grace!

My approach to leading over the years has been pretty simple. Becky and I do our best to discern the story God is writing and then step into His story, trusting Him by faith to open every door and provide what is needed. Our experience is that His story was always far larger than the one we would have written for ourselves. To lead God's people into His story has been the greatest privilege of our lives. The stories of God's transforming power continue to amaze us. This current season at Grace Woodlands is the most exciting we have ever had. While we have done our best to step into God's story, doing so has always involved people who were willing to take that step with us. How grateful we are for all of you who have done that in this unlikely time as God began a powerful new chapter for Grace Woodlands right in the beginning of Covid. I would have never picked that time on my own, but I have learned over the years that God's timing is generally never mine. And He always seems to add a little of the impossible to His story... so much so that you know you could never do this by yourself. During Covid as I sought the direction of the Lord, He said to me, "Call the people together to pray for 12 nights before Pentecost, and then make preparation for what I am going to do." I know that voice. I have heard it in every step of faith I have ever taken in the last five decades. How all of you who were a part of Grace at that time responded to those 12 nights was amazing to me. That alone confirmed to me that God was up to something beyond my expectations.

The time since then has been a season of God "breaking out" in a powerful way. The fruit of this season of "His presence and glory" is all around us. Even though we have expanded the current building to its maximum, it is now too small as we see God continue to expand in every area. I wondered how long this season would last, and as last summer was winding down that became the major focus of my personal time with the Lord. I could feel that things were beginning to change, and I wanted to know where God was going. In that time I heard Him respond to my inquiries with, "I have been adding, now I am going to multiply." I knew that our assignment was to prepare for what that would mean. Since that moment, God has begun giving me insight and opening doors for what will be a number of national initiatives to plant churches and assemble like-minded pastoral leaders who will faithfully stand in this evil day. Recent church plants in Florida and New Hampshire are the beginning nationally of God's word to us regarding multiplication. Those church plants are beyond our Texas directive to increase Grace International by fifty churches here. One pastor of a significant church here in Texas joined us last year and another is in the process of joining. We are meeting with several church plants that will be a part of our Texas initiative.

We are preparing for existing ministries at Grace Woodlands to multiply in size and scope and many new ministries to begin as we serve those the Lord is bringing our way in increasing numbers. We are making room for many more on our campus as we greatly increase our parking and are now moving forward with our Cornerstone capital campaign to construct our new worship center. None of this would have been possible or will be possible as we embrace our future of continuing to step into the story God is writing without people like you. By your praying, serving and giving, you birth everything of God's intent. For that, Becky and I are extremely grateful. I don't mention giving very much because I believe people who are growing in their faith and relationship with the Lord have an open heart and hand in investing their resources in God's kingdom. It is the only enduring investment there is. Every "WIN" in the advance of God's kingdom has eternal ramifications. Thank you for expressing the heart of God with your extravagant generosity as you seek the Lord and then make a sacrificial faith commitment beyond your regular giving to make our new worship center become a reality. That's what Becky and I are doing. We are so proud of all of you. What an exciting season to be involved in the story God is writing here at Grace.

Thank you for stepping into this amazing "God" story. Please, prayerfully, make the most generous sacrificial faith commitment that you can.

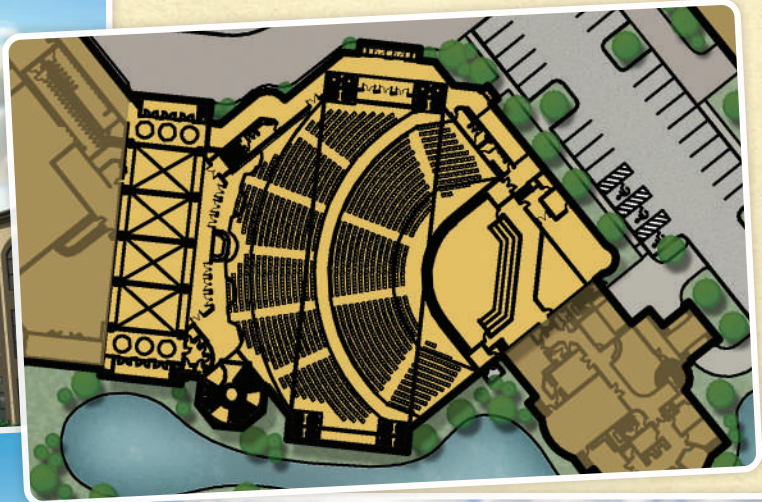
A BIBLICAL APPROACH FOR HOW TO BUILD A PLACE FOR GOD... A CORNERSTONE.

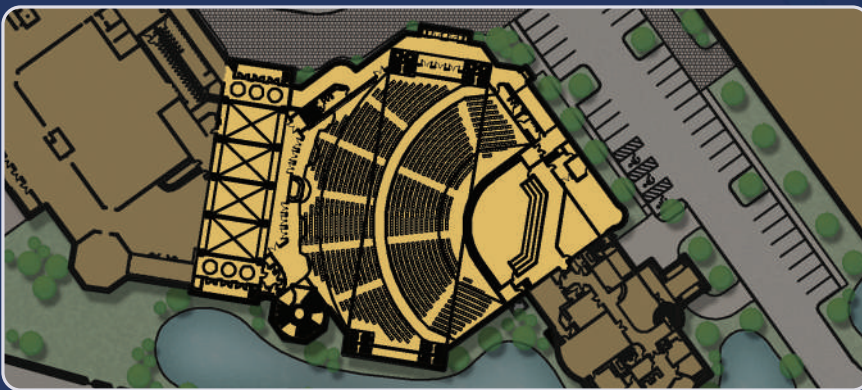

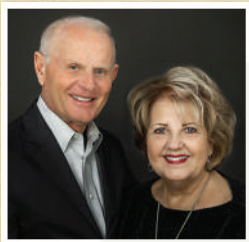
Lakefront park and plaza for various outdoor church and community events accommodating 3000+ for concerts and 1800 with tables.
